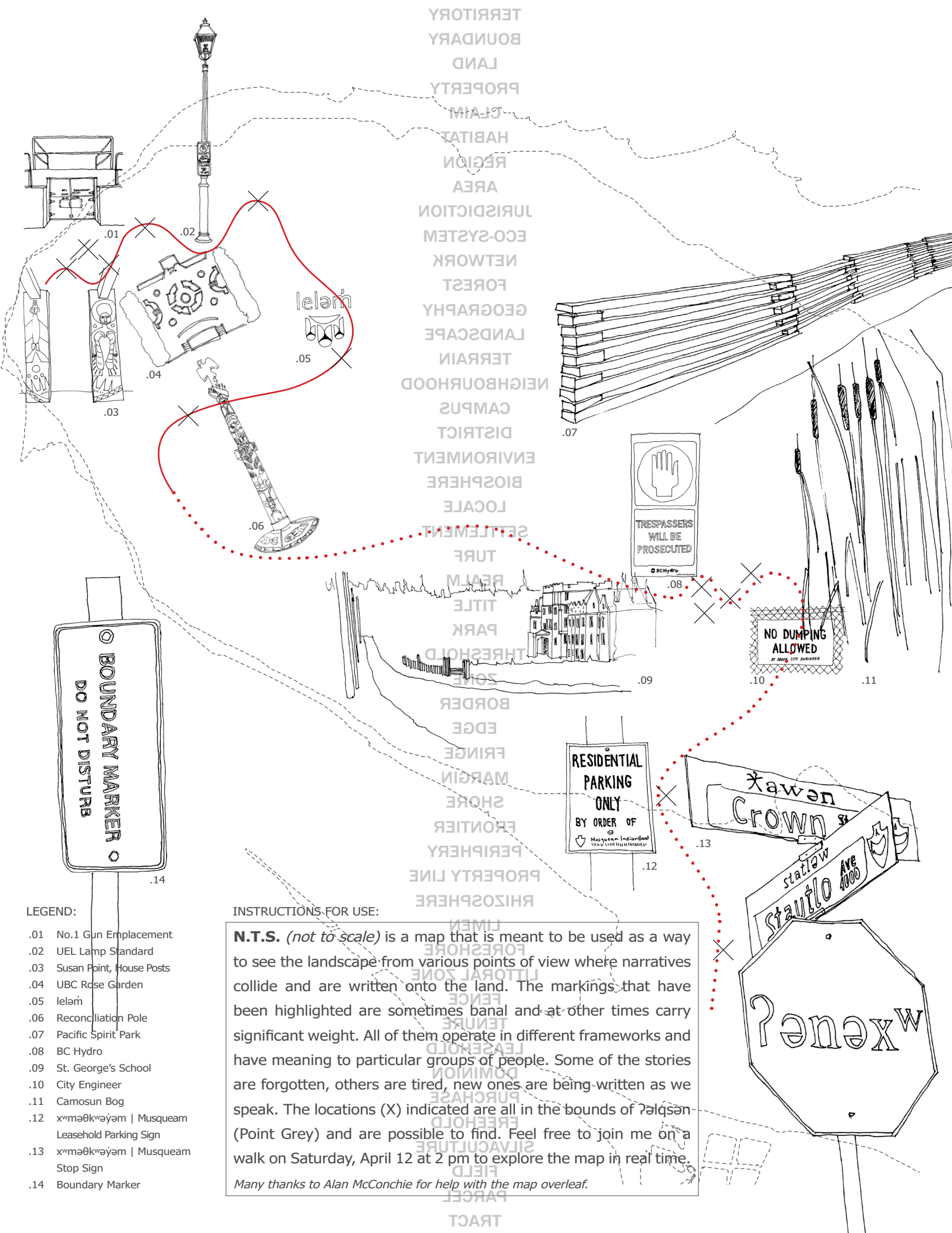

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

N.T.S. (not to scale) is a map that is meant to be used as a way to see the landscape from various points of view where narratives collide and are written onto the land. The markings that have been highlighted are sometimes banal and at other times carry significant weight. All of them operate in different frameworks and have meaning to particular groups of people. Some of the stories are forgotten, others are tired, new ones are being written as we speak. The locations (X) indicated are all in the bounds of ʔəlq̓sən (Point Grey) and are possible to find.
